## Windows

Uninstall as a (system) administrator. First stop the service `nuclos.<instance>` (default: `nuclos.nuclos`) via the control panel.

Remove the service via [Tomcat procrun](#) or by command:

```
sc delete nuclos.<instance>
```



### Registry

If registry remnants remain, remove these keys:

- `HKLM\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Uninstall\Nuclos`
- `HKLM\SOFTWARE\Wow6432Node\Apache Software Foundation\Procrun 2.0\nuclos.nuclos`
- `HKLM\SYSTEM\ControlSet001\services\nuclos.nuclos`

## Linux

1. Remove the contents of the Nuclos install directory.
2. Delete the entry in `/etc/nuclos.ini` (or remove the file):

```
[Nuclos (nuclos)]  
Path = /opt/nuclos
```
