3.4.1 Adjusting the data sources

The 5 data sources contained in the Nuclet, "CSV Export Type 1" (in the menu under "Configuration > Data sources > Report & form"), can be adapted at will to suit your own use case.

The data sources "CSV Export Type 1", "CSV Export Type 2" and "CSV Export Type 3" provide a parameterisation via two parameters "dat_from" and "dat_until" (data type: *Date*).

The data sources are coupled to the identically named CSV export types. That is, to run "CSV Export Type n" a CSV export with the export type "CSV Export Type n" must be used.
