Manual execution of exports

CSV exports can only be created and run manually:

1. Open the detail view "CSV Export" (menu path "CSV").
2. Create a new record.
3. Running the export incl. the final marking of all exported records (by clicking the "Export and process references" button).
4. Alternatively, the export can also be run as a preview only (by clicking the "Export" button).

The export data sources are coupled to the identically named CSV export types. That is, to run "CSV Export Type n" a CSV export with the export type "CSV Export Type n" must be used.

 Please make sure that the specified directory exists and is writable for the Nuclos service.
