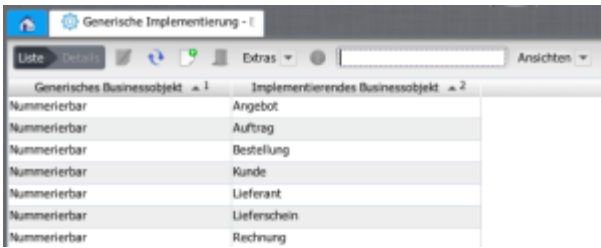
Overview

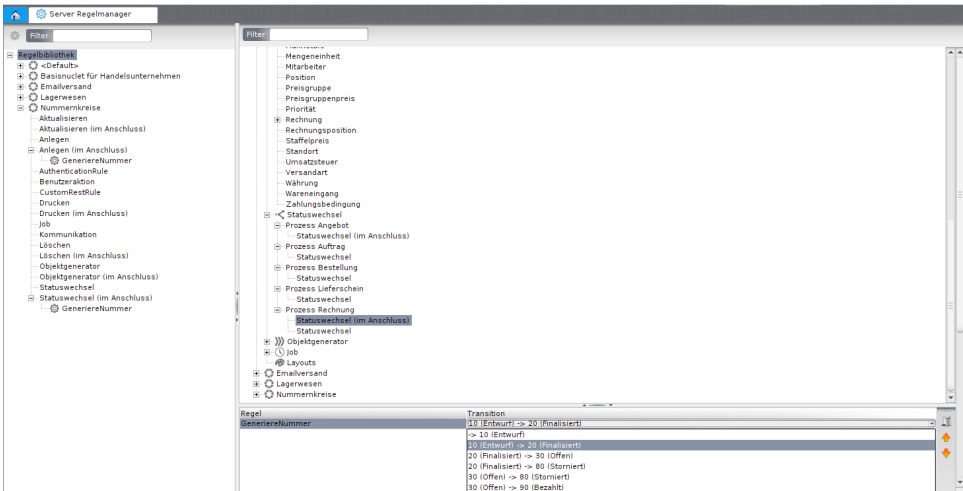
The "Number ranges" Nuclet enables the simple and automatic generation and assignment of unique numbers, e.g. order number, invoice number, etc.

Integration

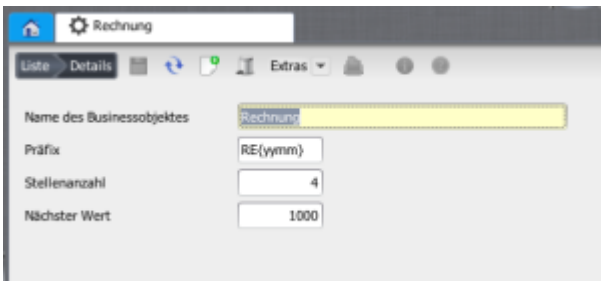
The integration after a successful Nuclet import (see [Nuclet import](#)) is to be carried out as follows.

 - yyyy, yyyymm, mmyyyy, yyyymmdd, yyyyddmm, ddmmyyyy, mmdyyy
 - mm, mmdd, ddmm, yymm, mmyy
 - dd, mm, yy
