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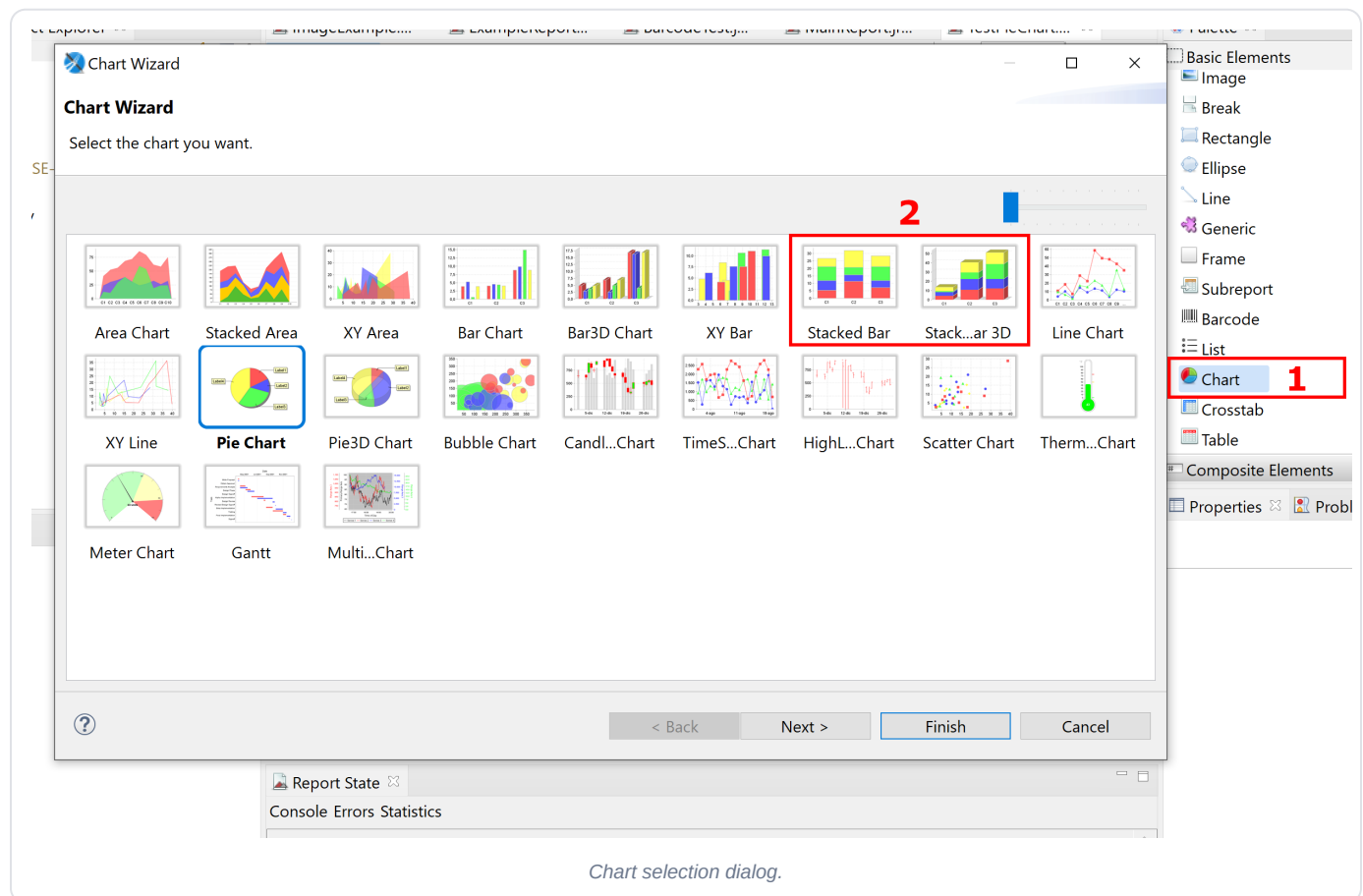
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What is a stacked bar chart for?

A stacked bar chart visualises the proportional development of **several categories over multiple points in time/steps**. Variants: *stacked bar* and *stacked bar 3D*.

Creating it in Jaspersoft Studio

1. Click the chart element in the palette and drag it onto the canvas – the chart selection dialog opens.
2. Choose the variant and confirm with *Next* (configure) or *Finish* (create immediately).



Configuration

Field	Meaning
Series	bar categories within a bar (also in the legend).
Value	value-determining field on the y-axis.
Category	unit on the x-axis (often a time unit).

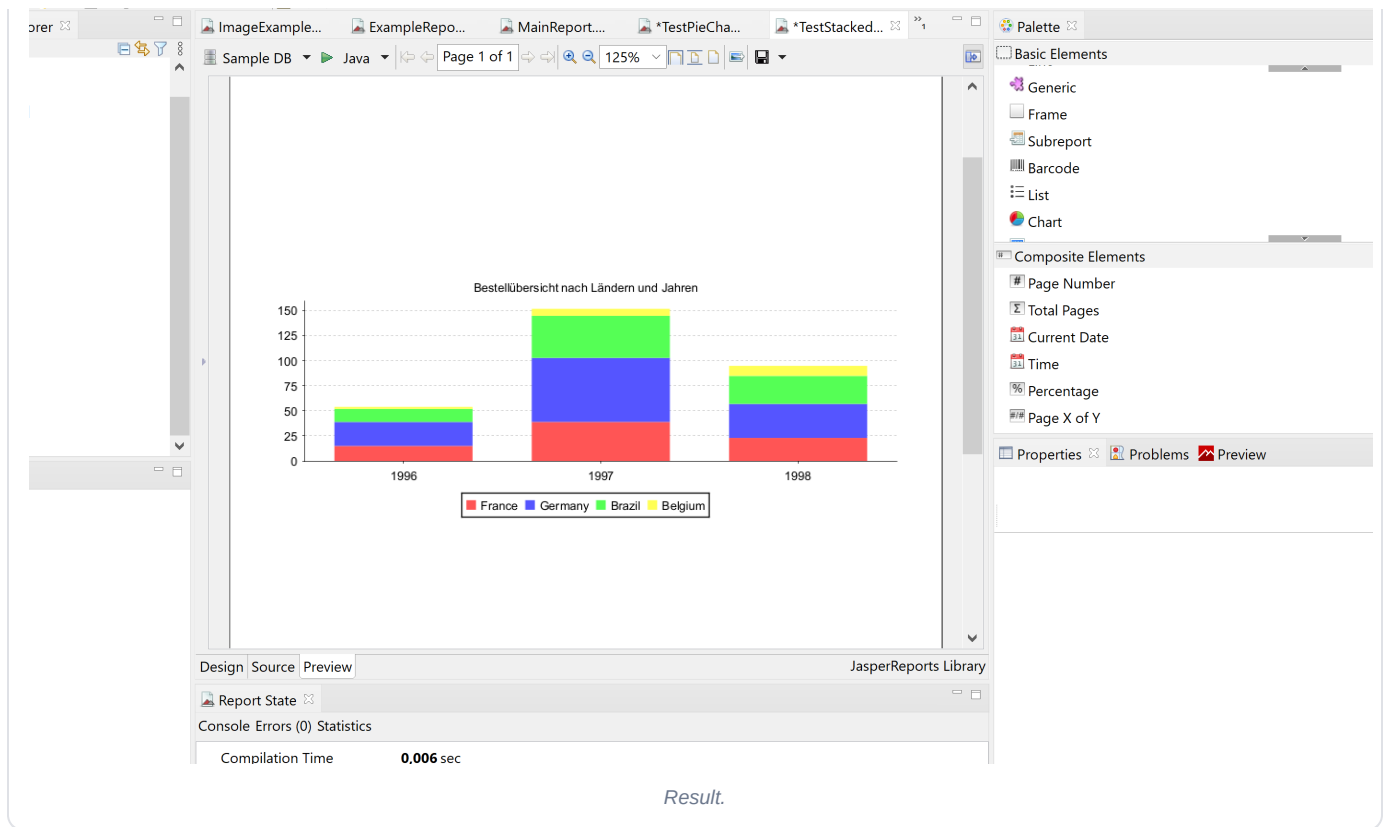
