Search form

In the search form you enter terms with operators and wildcards – all conditions are combined with AND.

Search form with terms.

Operators

Expression	Meaning
<All>	search across all values
=	value matches the term exactly
< / >	less / greater than (numbers, dates)
/	less-or-equal / greater-or-equal
	not equal (all but the term)
like / not like	matches (or not) with wildcards
is empty / is not empty	field empty resp. not empty
field compare	term is the value of another field
parameter compare	term is a parameter (e.g. current user)

Wildcards

Wildcard	Meaning
*	any number of characters (e.g. P* starts with P)
?	exactly one character (e.g. Pr?duct)
TODAY	date fields only: today's date
TODAY+/-nD or nM	today +/- n days resp. months



Example

Example: Surname S* finds all surnames starting with S; Date < 2010-01-01 all before it.
