Biometric login

Sign in with Face ID / Touch ID – securely per server, credentials only in device storage.

APPLIES TO NUCLOS APP 1.0

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The app can sign you in via **Face ID / Touch ID**. Credentials are stored only in the device's secure storage (iOS Keychain / Android Keystore) and read only after a successful biometric check.

Enable

1. First sign in once with username and password.
2. In [Settings](#) turn on the **Biometric login** switch for the current server and confirm the biometric check.



Per server

Activation is **per server**, so you can unlock several instances independently via Face ID / Touch ID.

Sign in

On the login screen biometric login is offered automatically; alternatively via **Biometric login**.

Disable

Turn off the switch in Settings – the stored credentials for that server are deleted. Other servers with active biometrics can be removed individually there.



Note

Biometric login is not available for anonymous sessions.
