### Security note

Disables certificate validation – for **testing/development** only, never in production.

General HTTPS access via `HttpsURLConnection` **without certificate validation** (`NullTrustManager/NullHostnameVerifier`):

        URL url = new URL(sUrl);
        URLConnection urlConnection = url.openConnection();
        InputStream is = urlConnection.getInputStream();

    }

    private static void trustAllCertificates() {
        try {
            TrustManager[] trustManagerArray = {new NullX509TrustManager()};
            SSLContext sc = SSLContext.getInstance("SSL");
            sc.init(null, trustManagerArray, null);
            HttpsURLConnection.setDefaultSSLSocketFactory(sc.getSocketFactory());
            HttpsURLConnection.setDefaultHostnameVerifier(new NullHostnameVerifier());
        } catch (Exception e) {

            return new X509Certificate[0];
        }
