Bundle attributes into groups and grant user-group- and status-dependent rights.

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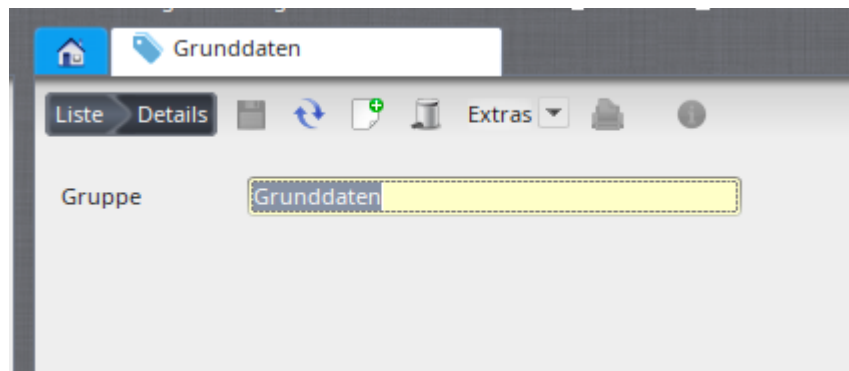
What are attribute groups?

Attribute groups bundle several attributes of a business object into a named group. Their main purpose: **fine-grained permissions** – read and write rights can be granted per user group and status.

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Creating

In the *attribute group* screen you create the groups; the **group** field defines the name.

Assigning & authorising attributes

Attributes are assigned to a group in the [BO wizard](#). Using the [status model](#) you then grant user-group- and status-dependent rights: a user group can be given read-only access or no access at all to a group's attributes for certain business objects (depending on the current status).
