Why Jaspersoft Studio?

Nuclos generates forms and reports via **JasperReports**. The report engine is given an XML blueprint (.jrxml). While this could be written with any text editor, **Jaspersoft Studio** is far more convenient:

- graphical editing of JRXML files,
- connecting your own databases to test with real data,
- compilation & preview,
- custom font extensions.



Version note

From version 4.50 Nuclos uses the Jaspersoft library 6.17.0; the guides were created with Jaspersoft Studio 6.17.0. Higher versions usually work because reports can be exported for older library versions.
