

Linux Appliance (EN)

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Run the Nuclos Launcher on Linux as an Appliance – incl. libfuse2 and optional desktop integration.

HOW-TO

USER

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APPLIES TO NUCLOS 4.2026.X

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Prerequisite: libfuse2

Current Linux distributions need libfuse2 to load Appliances:

```
sudo apt-get install libfuse2 zlib1g-dev
```

Start

With execute permission the launcher starts directly:

```
chmod +x Nuclos_Launcher_*.Appliance
```

Desktop integration (optional)

For seamless integration (start menu, auto-updates) we recommend [ApplianceLauncher](#):

```
bash -c 'set -e; A=$(dpkg --print-architecture); case "$A" in amd64|arm64) F="applauncher_2.2.0_${A}-bionic.deb"; *) echo "Not supported architecture: $A" >&2; exit 1;; esac; U="https://launchpad.net/applauncher/2.x/v2.2.0/+download/$F"; wget -qO "/tmp/$F" "$U"; sudo apt-get install "/tmp/$F"; rm "/tmp/$F"'
```
