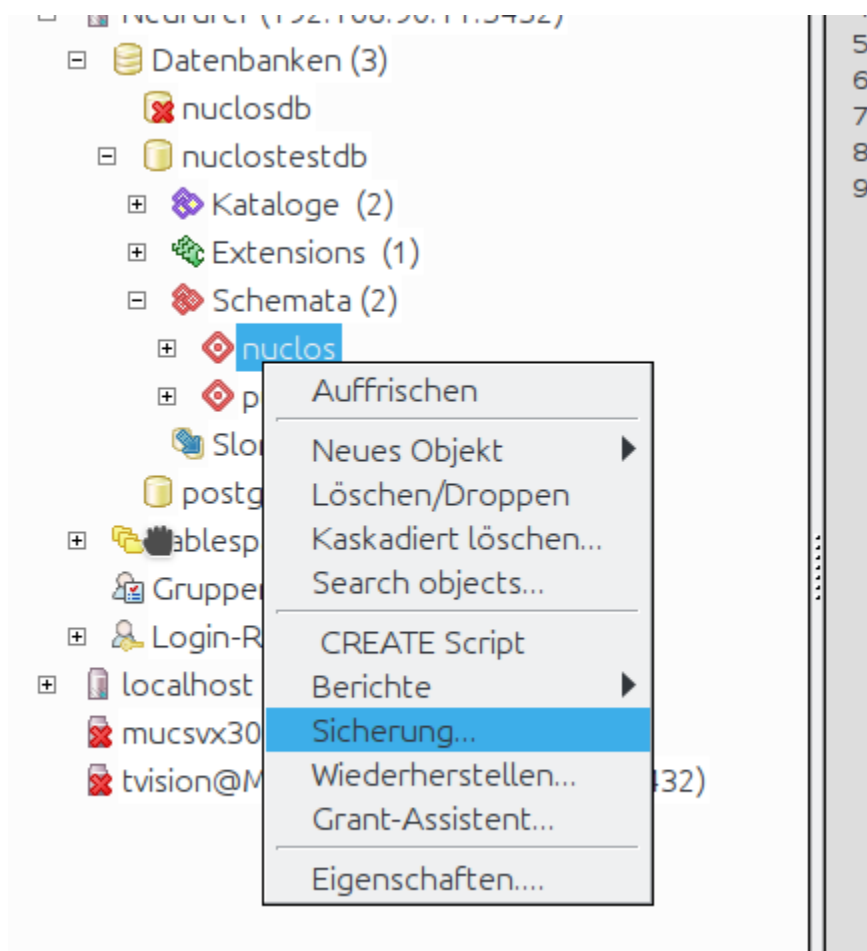

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Alternatively a PostgreSQL dump can be created graphically via **pgAdmin**.

Step by step

1. Open pgAdmin.
2. Right-click the schema and choose *Backup...*
3. Save the dump to a target directory with the extension *.backup.



pgAdmin: back up the schema.
