Overview of multilingualism in Nuclos – interface language vs. data language and where they are configured.

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For the internationalization of Nuclos, **three aspects** must be distinguished:

Aspect	What	Term
Nuclos UI	language-specific menus, forms, dialogs of Nuclos itself	interface language
Nuclet UI	translation of nuclet content (BO names, layouts, state model ...)	interface language
Data	maintain individual field content multilingually (e.g. article names)	data language

Interface language and data language can be set **separately**: a foreign-language user usually also wants to see foreign-language data content – so Nuclos offers both settings independently.

Where to configure?

- Interface languages:** via [localization](#) (from 4.2025) – incl. automatic translation.
- Data languages:** via the [data language](#) administration.
