How Nuclos version numbers are composed – scheme, examples and the 2022 change.

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Since 2022 the Nuclos version contains the **release year**. A version is structured as follows:

MAJOR . YEAR . COUNTER [. BUGFIX]

Part	Meaning	Example
MAJOR	Major version (rare)	4
YEAR	Release year	2026
COUNTER	Sequential, reset to 1 each year	31
BUGFIX	Only for bugfix releases	1

Examples

Release type	Version	Git branch/tag
Minor release	4 . 2026 . 1	4 . 2026 . 1
Bugfix release	4 . 2026 . 1 . 1	4 . 2026 . 1



Change in 2022

Changes compared to the old scheme (until 2021, e.g. 4 . 53 . 0): the year is also part of the minor segment, the counter restarts at 1 every year and the bugfix segment only appears for bugfix releases.
